












History

➤ May 2005: Cabinet approval for the transfer of legal oversight of five categories of drinking water systems from the Ministry of the Environment (MOE) to the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC).

Large municipal non-residential (e.g., municipally-owned airports and industrial parks, large sports and recreation facilities)

Small municipal non-residential (e.g., small community centres, libraries, sports and recreation facilities)

Non-municipal seasonal residential (e.g., private cottages on communal drinking water systems)

Large non-municipal non-residential (e.g., large motels and resorts) **Small non-municipal non-residential** (e.g., motels, restaurants, gas stations, churches, Bed and Breakfasts).
