Infant mental health promotion - Attachment enhancing programmes





- In high income countries 40% insecure attachment by age 18 months
- Structured programmes are effective 70 RCTs
- Interpretation of infant signals use of photos or video clips
- Introduced in established parent support groups at CHC

Structured methods for parents of children age 3-9 years, based on methods like PMT, COPE etc. adapted for universal use in Sweden...





 - 3 months partly paid

















Requirements for quality = advantageous long term effects of pre schools
